

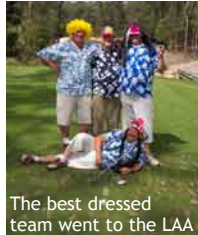
## The 2005 Industry Charity Golf Day

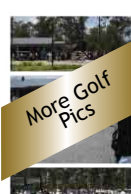

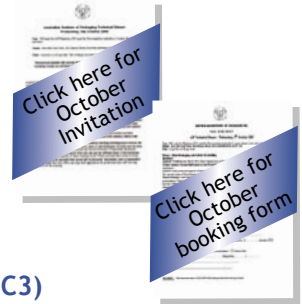
